For ten years since its founding in 2001, AirAsia has rapidly grown into Asia's largest low-cost carrier. Since then, its fleet of aircraft increased from just two to over 100 and the number of annual passengers grew from 200,000 to over 120 million. Through this lecture, you can find out the reasons behind the long haul low fare airline's success.

The speaker will be Mr. Azran Osman-Rani, CEO of AirAsia X, who will arrive at Osaka on the airline's first flight from Malaysia to Kansai International Airport. He will talk about the long haul low fare airline's innovative business model, its future business development plans, how to generate innovation that makes the impossible possible, and the secret to making things happen.
