

“Business Startup Seminar” Conducted by O-BIC and MIPRO

Under the cosponsorship of O-BIC (Osaka Business and Investment Center) and MIPRO (Manufactured Imports and Investment Promotion Organization), “Business Start-up Seminar in Osaka for Foreign Residents in Japan” was held on May 31, 2010.



The first main presentation at the Seminar was made by Mr. Kim Hongki (President, Intelligent Trans Lab Inc.) who, based on his own experiences, dealt with some difficulties felt by foreign business starters in the Japanese markets, offering constructive advice for those considering such business start-up; followed by Mr. Shuji Takahashi (MIPRO Investment Adviser, Administrative Scrivener) who provided concrete details on the procedures for setting up a company as well as on the eligibility for being resident.

An O-BIC Official introduced the main background to Osaka referring to its free and independent-spirited culture attracting enterprising entrepreneurs and their globally operating businesses, with particular emphasis on Osaka’s advantages for foreign business starters.



The Seminar was attended by 39 keen participants including foreigners currently residing and students from overseas now studying at universities in Osaka/Kansai, as well as others who have opportunities to be asked by foreigners for consultation.
